What to bring: Weather conditions in Glacier are often unpredictable and can change rapidly so be prepared for any type of weather-hot, cold, wet, dry, etc. We will hike regardless of weather, rain or shine. We suggest that you bring a backpack, your own water and sack lunch, hat, rain gear, sunglasses, sunscreen and whatever else you might need. We strongly encourage hikers to bring a can of bear spray. GNPF has cans available to borrow for the day upon signing a waiver. The hiking schedule is as follows:

July 31 st at 9 am	Virginia Falls	3.6 miles, 285 ft	Easy
August 7 th at 10 am	Two Medicine – around the lake	7.0 miles, 300 ft	Easy
August 14 th at 8 am	Gunsight Lake	12.4 miles, 800 ft	Moderate
August 21 st at 8 am	Many Glacier-TBD	Depends on trail closures	Most hikes in the area are Moderate
August 28 th at 8 am	Firebrand Pass	9.6 miles, 2,210 ft	Moderately Strenuous
